Assistant State's Attorney Jaymi Sterling is an accomplished veteran prosecutor with the Anne Arundel County State's Attorney's Office where she prosecutes violent felony crimes and acts as a liaison to the Anne Arundel County Police Department's fatal overdose investigators. Ms. Sterling previously served as the Chief of Staff and Deputy State's Attorney for the St. Mary's County State's Attorney's Office and Special Assistant United State's Attorney with the United States Attorney's Office.

Ms. Sterling frequently testifies in front of the Maryland General Assembly advocating for stronger protections for crime victims and safer communities. She was recently awarded the "Law Enforcement Officer of the Year" for the St. Mary's County State's Attorney's Office.

Ms. Sterling was elected to serve two terms as President of the St. Mary's County Bar Association and now sits on its Board of Directors in addition to the St. Mary's County Shop with a Cop, Inc. Executive Board and the Calvert County Marine Museum Board of Governors.

Former United States Attorney for the District of Maryland Robert Hur and Maryland Governor Larry Hogan recently appointed Ms. Sterling to serve on the Governor's Asian American Hate Crimes Workgroup, a statewide body charged with developing strategies, recommendations, and actions to address the rise in violence and discrimination targeting the Asian American community.
